

## **Absolutely Stunning— Wow!**

Tour the Allegheny National Forest of northwestern PA to enjoy the lush green forests of summer and the brilliantly vivid colors of the area's Fall foliage!

## **Road Trip in the Allegheny National Forest**

Check into your lodging in **Bradford**, PA, which will become your lodging hub while touring the region.

**DAY 1:** Begin at the **Kinzua Sky Walk** rated "One of the Top Ten most scenic skywalks in the World," located at the **Kinzua Bridge State Park** in Mt. Jewett. Drive Rt. 6 west to enjoy a casual lunch at the **Barrel House Restaurant & Tavern** in Lantz Corners. Stop at **Flickerwood Wine Cellars** to sample their award-winning wines.

Travel Rt. 6 west to the village of Kane. Tour the **Kane Discovery Center** to learn about Lobo Wolves, and shop for local artisan wares at **Artworks at the Summit**. Foodies will enjoy a visit to **Bell's Meat & Poultry Shop**, an old-fashioned family-owned grocery store, known far and wide for their delicious sausage, cheeses and specialty foods. Enjoy the libations available from **Logyard Brewing**, **CJ Spirits** and **Twisted Vine**, crafted from local ingredients and the fresh mountain waters of the Alleghenies.

**DAY 2:** In the morning, just minutes from your lodging is the **Zippo/Case Museum**; stop in for the storied history of the Zippo Lighter. Enjoy a musical experience at the **Marilyn Horne Museum**. Stop at the ANF Visitors Bureau Welcome Center for a walking tour

brochure of **Bradford's National Historic District**, view the eclectic architecture built by the oil barons, explore the local shops and restaurants.

Depart for Smethport. **Smethport's Mansion District Walking Tour** takes you past
beautiful examples of Victorian architecture.
Explore the haunted dungeon at the **Old Jail Museum**. It's on to the **Eldred WWII Museum**where you can see, feel and touch history.

**DAY 3:** Begin your morning with breakfast and a pastry treat from **John Williams Pastry Shop**. Have the **Grocery Stretcher** pack you a picnic lunch from their selection of Amish foods. Enjoy a hike and lunch at scenic **Marilla Reservoir**, which offers a variety of trails.

Just three miles south, along Rt. 219 is the Penn Brad Oil Museum, learn about the "Bradford Sands" the world's first billion dollar oil field. Back to nature, take Rt. 59 into the Allegheny National Forest to explore the beauty of the forest along the Longhouse National Scenic Byway. Rimrock Overlook offers stunning views. Enjoy sunset at the Kinzua Wolf Run Marina while dining outside at Docksider's Café.
