FAYETTEVILLE, WV - Start your journey at the NPS Canyon Rim Visitors Center. Then head down to Nuttallburg part of the NPS New River Gorge. Nuttallburg was the focus of Industrialist Henry Ford, in the 1920's, who leased the town's mines to provide coal for his company steel mills.
