We are called Oregon Unexpected because people are surprised by how much there is to see and do with 300+ days of sunshine. With an abundance of cultural history and some of the most beautiful and authentic nature experiences anywhere, Klamath explodes with activity. Hike at Crater Lake National Park or Lava Beds National Monument. Golf Oregon's only Arnold Palmer Signature Golf Course at the Running Y Ranch.

### Day 1

Leave the driving to the folks at the Crater Lake Trolley while you take-in the astonishing sights of the deepest blue lake in the United States and Oregon's only national park, Crater Lake. Hike down to the deep blue waters on the Cleetwood Cove Trail and enjoy a guided boat tour. The view from the water is profound. You may even decide to take a swim! Or spend part of your day hiking the Pacific Crest Trail well known from the movie "Wild" with Reese Witherspoon. It's accessible from Crater Lake National Park.

# Day 2

Spend the following day exploring some of the 700 caves at the Lava Beds National Monument. Walk the footsteps of Captain Jack's Stronghold where a small band of Modoc Indians were besieged by a US army force outnumbering them as much as ten to one during the Modoc Indian War of 1872-1873. View the large rock art collection at Petroglyph Point where early Modoc Indians paddled out in boats to carve in the cliff face. End your day at the captivating Favell Museum and view over 100,000 Indian artifacts including arrowheads, native clothing, intricate beadwork and more.

# Day 3

Begin your next day at the only Arnold Palmer Signature Golf Course located at the Running Y Ranch Resort. Golfers from around the globe are blown away by the challenge and jaw-dropping setting of this award-winning golf course. Enjoy the afternoon at any of 6 National Wildlife Refuges in Klamath County. This "Birder's Paradise" is a popular stop on the Pacific Flyway where you can easily view many of the 300+ species of migrating birds. Observe Bald Eagles, blue herons, grebes, egrets, Sandhill cranes and many more.
