Falling Waters State Park

Discover what makes this park so unique. See the tallest waterfall in Florida as it cascades and disappears into a sinkhole. While strolling through the park, you'll learn of a civil war ear grist mill, the first oil well in the state and the 5,000 year history of Native Americans that called these lands home. The park also offers camping, swimming, fishing and other nature based activities for your enjoyment.

Enjoy a ride on a Tennessee Walker through the beautiful sandhills and forests of the Econfina Creek Water Management District. Overnight camping trips are also available and lessons

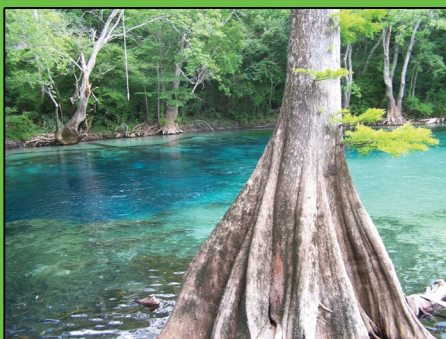


Seacrest Wolf Preserve

This unforgettable experience takes visitors on a walking journey into large natural habitats that are home to Gray, Arctic and British Columbian wolves, where they become part of the pack! This includes the small animal adventure where you can feed raccoons, hug a skunk, play with foxes and meet Pacos the Coyote and laugh with Billie the groundhog.

Holmes Creek & Cypress Spring

Take a leisurely paddle down Holmes Creek taking in the beautiful flora and fauna and end at the crystal clear 2nd magnitude Cypress Spring. This spring is 30 ft deep and a consistent 70 degrees year round.
